GRANT: Tonight's all-star lineup: Rod Brasfield! Minnie Pearl! Granpa Jones! Del Wood! and the entire Opry gang!

DICKENS: And our special guest is a girl. I mean, she is a girl! I'm talking about the Decca Record Star: Patsy Cline!

MUSIC: <sup>8:38.54</sup> PATSY CLINE.. "A CHURCH, A COURTROOM, AND THEN GOODBYE"

(APPLAUSE)

INTO FIDDLE..'OLD JOE CLARK'...FADE FOR:

DICKENS: <sup>8:39.45</sup> Real fine, Patsy. I don't know about the rest of you fellas but I'm dancin' with Patsy Cline as the Grand Ole Opry square dancers cut a caper to "Old Joe Clark"!

MUSIC: <sup>8:39.50</sup> SQUARE DANCE..."OLD JOE CLARK"

(APPLAUSE)

INTO ACCORDIAN IN BG.....

DICKENS: <sup>8:40.50</sup> We'd like to pause right here in the midst of all our Grand Ole Opry singing, dancin' and fun -- and take up an old, old Opry custom -- the singing of a sacred song. (AD LIB INTO SONG)

MUSIC: <sup>8:40.10</sup> DICKENS..."TAKE MY HAND PRECIOUS LORD"

(APPLAUSE)

DICKENS: <sup>8:43.10</sup> (READ EXACTLY AS WRITTEN FOR NETWORK CUE) Thank you, folks, thanks a whole lot. Well, here comes a friend of yours with something mighty important on his mind.

(GRANT OVER)

GRANT: Do certain days stick in your mind, Jimmy?

DICKENS: Some do, Grant.

GRANT: Do you recall the day you first rolled up a makin's cigarette with Prince Albert?

Till then, this is Jimmy Dickens sayin' thanks for everything and we'll be seein' you next week at the Grand Ole Opry!
